Saturday / Monday / Thursday

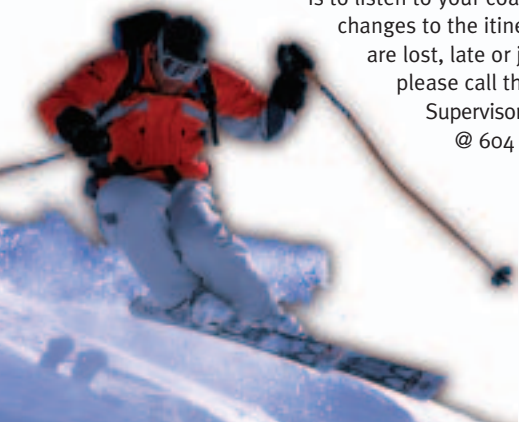
- 8:30 Meet outside on the deck of Essentially Blackcomb in the main village between the Whistler & Blackcomb gondolas.

- 12:30-2:30 Video analysis run.
- 2:30 Continue introduction to the steps for the remainder of the day.

#### DAY TWO:

Sunday / Tuesday / Friday

- 8:30 Meet outside on the deck of Essentially Blackcomb in the main village between the Whistler & Blackcomb gondolas.
- 8:45 Head up Blackcomb Mountain for a few warm up runs. Guided coaching focusing on technique in the steeps.
- 9:00-11:45 Viewing & analysis of video.
- 11:45 Lunch at coach's choice of restaurant.
- 12:15 Continue working on technique in the steeps.
- 3:30 Beer & nacho decompression session at Merlin's Bar & Grill.
